Program Support

Our Programs & Services directly impact the lives of people in our community who are affected by epilepsy. Join us in making a difference in someone's life!



Youth Council

A leadership and volunteer program for youth ages 11-21 who are living with or impacted by epilepsy.

Members work together and independently to raise awareness, share stories and feel empowered about living with epilepsy.



PACES Facilitator

Program of Active Consumer Engagement of Epilepsy - focused on improving quality of life through self management courses.

Peers offer weekly check ins with current participants and attend weekly 1-hour sessions. 8 week commitment.



Community Action Network

CAN is a group for adult volunteers impacted by epilepsy

Mission: bring the Epilepsy Foundation into communities through support, awareness, fundraising, creating activities, and socializing.



Health Fairs

Raise awareness and offer support by representing the Foundation at local health fairs and other community events.



Support Group Leader

Lead support group (2 hour meeting each month), virtual or In-Person. Participate in regular check-ins with the Care Navigation Manger. 1.5 hour training.



Seizure First Aid

Get certified as a Seizure Recognition & First Aid Trainer, and partner with the Epilepsy Foundation programs team to offer training in area schools, businesses, etc.
